Notes to the financial results:

- 1 This statement has been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable.
- The above financial results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on May 7, 2019. The statutory auditors have carried out the limited review for the quarter ended March 31, 2019 and have issued an unmodified opinion.
- 3 Figures of the quarter ended December 31, 2018 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the relevant full financial year and the published year to date figures up to third quarter of relevant financial year.
- 4 Effective January 1, 2019 the Company has adopted Ind AS 115 'Revenue from Contracts with Customers', Ind AS 115 is replacing existing revenue recognition standards viz Ind AS 18 'Revenue' and Ind AS 11 'Construction Contracts', Using the modified retrospective approach, there was no adjustments required to the retained earnings as at January 1, 2019. Also the adoption of the Ind AS 115 did not have any material impact on the recognition and measurement of revenue and related items in the financial results of the Company.
- Pursuant to the Board of Directors' in principle approval in the previous year ended December 31, 2016 for the sale of the office space ("Beck House"), at Pune, the Company had classified the written down value of the property amounting to Rs. 521.08 lakhs as 'Asset held for sale' under 'Other current assets'. The Company had executed the sale deed for the said property on January 5, 2018 for a consideration of Rs. 2,500 lakhs. The resultant profit on sale of the property was treated as an exceptional item during the year ended December 31, 2018.

- 6 On March 6, 2019, the Company was directed for closure of its operations in Ankleshwar by the Gujarat Pollution Control Board (GPCB) due to a suspected water contamination issue, GPCB through its order dated April 4, 2019, has granted temporary revocation of 3 months to the closure order. The Company has represented to GPCB for a permanent revocation of the closure order and is doing all the necessary acts, deeds and things in that connection.
- 7 The Company is in the process of evaluating the impact of the recent Supreme Court Judgment in case of "Vivekananda Vidyamandir And Others Vs The Regional Provident Fund Commissioner (II) West Bengal" and the related circular (Circular No. C-I/1(33)2019/Vivekananda Vidya Mandir/284) dated March 20, 2019 issued by the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation in relation to non-exclusion of certain allowances from the definition of "basic wages" of the relevant employees for the purposes of determining contribution to provident fund under the Employees' Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952. In the assessment of the management, the aforesaid matter is not likely to have a significant impact and accordingly, no provision has been made during the quarter ended March 31, 2019
